Psalm 121

The personal questions as to where to find help in the mountain that is before the psalmist coupled with the quick answer it is in his God who made the heavens and earth.

All the extremes that make God over it all . . .

The transition between verse 1-2 on the personal side (I and my) to others (you and yours) in verses 3-8.

Either the Psalmist is so excited about he discovered that he had to tell others about it or he is talking to himself in order to set himself straight with the truth about God.

God is your steady shepherd ever watchful and awake to you (3-4)

God is your strong champion ever vigilant and present with us (5-6)

God is your soul protector everlasting and protective of you (7-8)

The repeated mention of “keeper” in verse 3,4,5,7and 8

Application: The problems you and I face are bigger than we can handle but not for God.

The experiences, thoughts, concerns, worries, emotions, that we have and seem monumental to us are in fact momentary to God. We need to get on His page and let His page fill us.

Move once again but this time more free and full than ever whatever this may cost us.
