It’s now about offering ourselves wholeheartedly to God

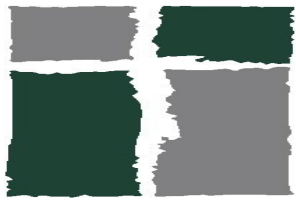
It’s no longer about “carrying the burden” of life all alone
