Chapter 7 . . .

The illustration from Chapter 6:2 and the questions from Chapter 6:12 that set up Chapter 7

Persian Proverb:

If you know and know not that you know you’re asleep—wake up!
If you know not and know that you know not you’re a student—study up!
If you know no and know not that you know not you’re a fool—wise up!
If you know you know that you know you’re wise—lead out!

Verses 1-12, 15-29 list 5 proverbs . . .

It is better to be at a funeral than at a party (1-2)

It is better to be criticized than to laugh (3-6)

It is better to look ahead than behind (7-10)

It is better to have wisdom than money (11-12)

It is better to be declared by God than to be determined by yourself or someone other than yourself (15-29)

Verses 13-14 are the key verses that unlock the meaning of this chapter . . .

Application: **Don’t** be slow in thanking and praising God
Don’t be quick to blame and envy others
