Some notes to help to understand the passage:

Those **NEAR BY** - Jesus' Homies in Capernaum & Nazareth

Those **BY HIS SIDE** - the crowds

Those **ON HIGH** - elite Roman royal nobility

Those that are going **BYE BYE** - Jesus, John the Baptist, disciples, and us

Choose this day whether you will be offended, will be opportunistic, will be offensive, or will be obedient even to the point of death.

There is nothing superficial or insignificant about our gathering together in God's name and for His glory. Our gathering together is to be supernatural, lawful, ethical, and life transforming.. It is intended to bless us not curse us. It is designed by God to secure us not to scandalize us or others around us. Our gatherings are to be the grand accomplishment of God, the crowning jewel of Jesus, and the marvelous missionary fulfillment of the Holy Spirit.

What is your view of congregating?

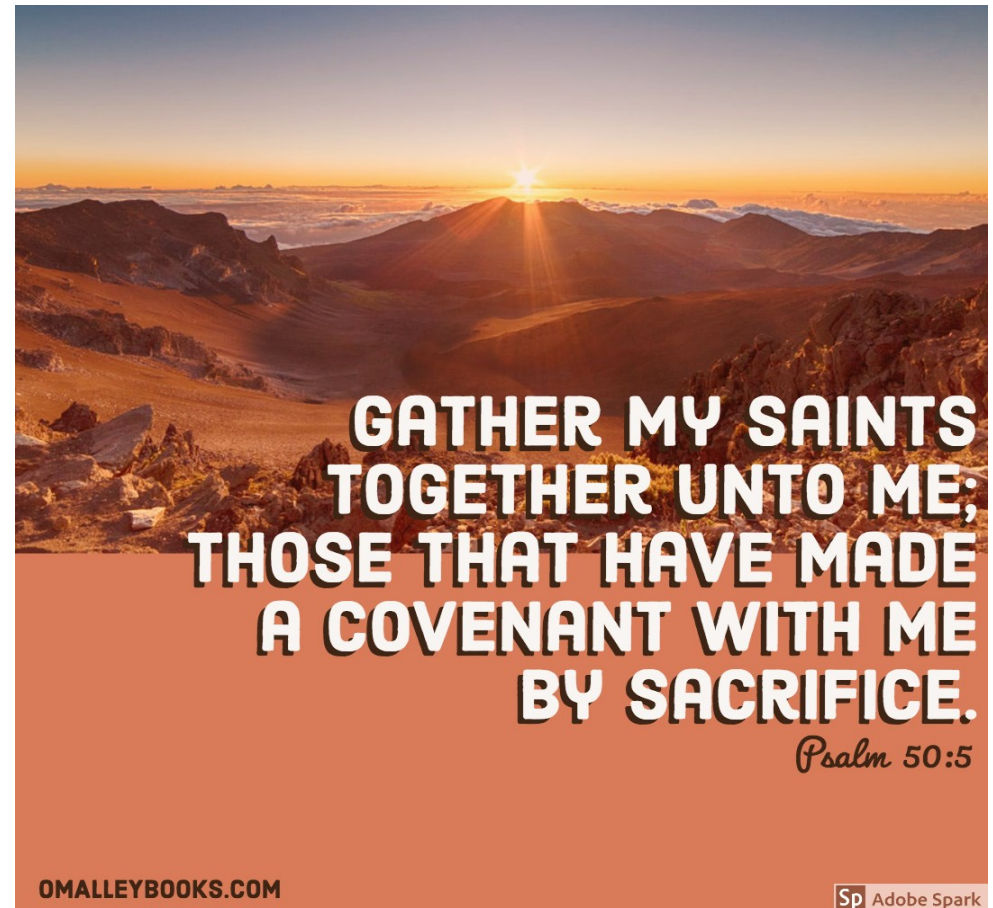
This passage contrasts a cursed path of mad unbelievers with the blessed path of mourning believers. What happens when these two kingdoms clash and these two paths crash into one another?
